Planning Grant Application Update

One of the major reasons for cancelling the February 4th previously scheduled Board meeting is the fact that there is no additional clarity or certainty to report to the Board on the Gulf Consortium's Planning Grant Application. The application was submitted to the Restoration Council on September 24. Since that time, Consortium staff and consultants have been working with the Restoration Council to achieve closure on the Council's questions and concerns. The Consortium has been in constant communication with the Council since September; has shared volumes of documentation; and answered every question posed. At the request of the Consortium's Chairman, Commissioner Grover Robinson (Escambia) a face to face meeting with DEP, Consortium and Council staff will take place February 12. Revisions to the Process for Development of the State Expenditure Plan

Because of some of the preliminary policy issues that the Board has made with

respect to the process for developing Florida's state expenditure plan, the ESA Consultant Team's approach to that process needs to be revised. Each of the Executive Committee meetings between now and April will include discussions on any revisions to the process for developing Florida's state expenditure plan.
